



**Scholarship for members of female institutes of consecrated life, societies of apostolic life and secular institutes: Licentiate in Spiritual Theology or Theological Anthropology**

The Carmel Forum Foundation announces two scholarships for members of female institutes of consecrated life, apostolic societies and secular institutes for the two-year cycle of the Licentiate in Spiritual Theology or Theological Anthropology at the Pontifical Theological Faculty - Pontifical Institute of Spirituality "Teresianum".

Scholarships are granted for a period of two years and cover only and fully academic fees (funds are paid directly to the faculty for the fees due: two annual enrolments, delivery of the thesis, final examination, degree diploma for a total of 3'850 € for every grant). The grants are renewable after the first year on condition of renewal of enrolment.

**APPLICATION INFORMATION**

The scholarships are intended for members of female institutes of consecrated life, societies of apostolic life and secular institutes who have not passed the age of forty and who possess a university degree of Baccalaureate (or equivalent) and all the requirements necessary for enrolment in the second cycle of Licentiate at the Pontifical Theological Faculty - Pontifical Institute of Spirituality "Teresianum".

- a) Motivation Letter (about 300 words) explaining the reasons for undertaking Licentiate studies at the Teresianum, whether personal or related to one's Institute or the local Church;
- b) Curriculum Vitae, including detailed information about the candidate's religious, scholastic and academic training, language skills, as well as any other information the candidate deems useful;
- c) photocopy of an identity document;
- d) a letter of presentation from the Major Superior stating the intention to devote the student after the completion of her studies at the Teresianum to theological research, teaching or some other service for which the Licentiate studies would be useful.

Applications for scholarships must be submitted by 9 September 2022. A decision will be communicated by 22 September 2022.
